7. What equipment and/or technologies do you use? (software/hardware)
8. What kind of training did you undertake?
9. Do you have any creative projects outside of work?
10. Any suggestions for an artist to get "noticed" early in their career?
11. What do you love about your career?
12. What do you wish was different about your career?
13. Did you have any mentors or support, or lack of mentors and support?
14. Can you describe the best day of your job so far? Worst day?
15. What subjects, if any, in high school, help you today in the workplace?
16. What do you wish you had learned in high school that would have better prepared you for the workplace?
17. What advice would you give to high school students looking into your career path?
18. What else could someone with your background do? What other careers have you considered for yourself?
19. Is there anything about today's economic climate that affects your job or the clients that you work with?
20. Why is it important for young people to think about these types of careers at such an early age?
